4. You must participate in the Counsellor Training.
5. You must provide a criminal record check if applicable.
6. Preference (helpful but not essential): Previous participation in Confirmation Camp.
7. If you are an alumnus/alumna of Confirmation Camp, then you must not return to Confirmation Camp to serve as a Counsellor until one year has elapsed. To put it in more common terms: we want you to "take a break" for one year between the time you were a Confirmand and the time you will serve as a Counsellor.
